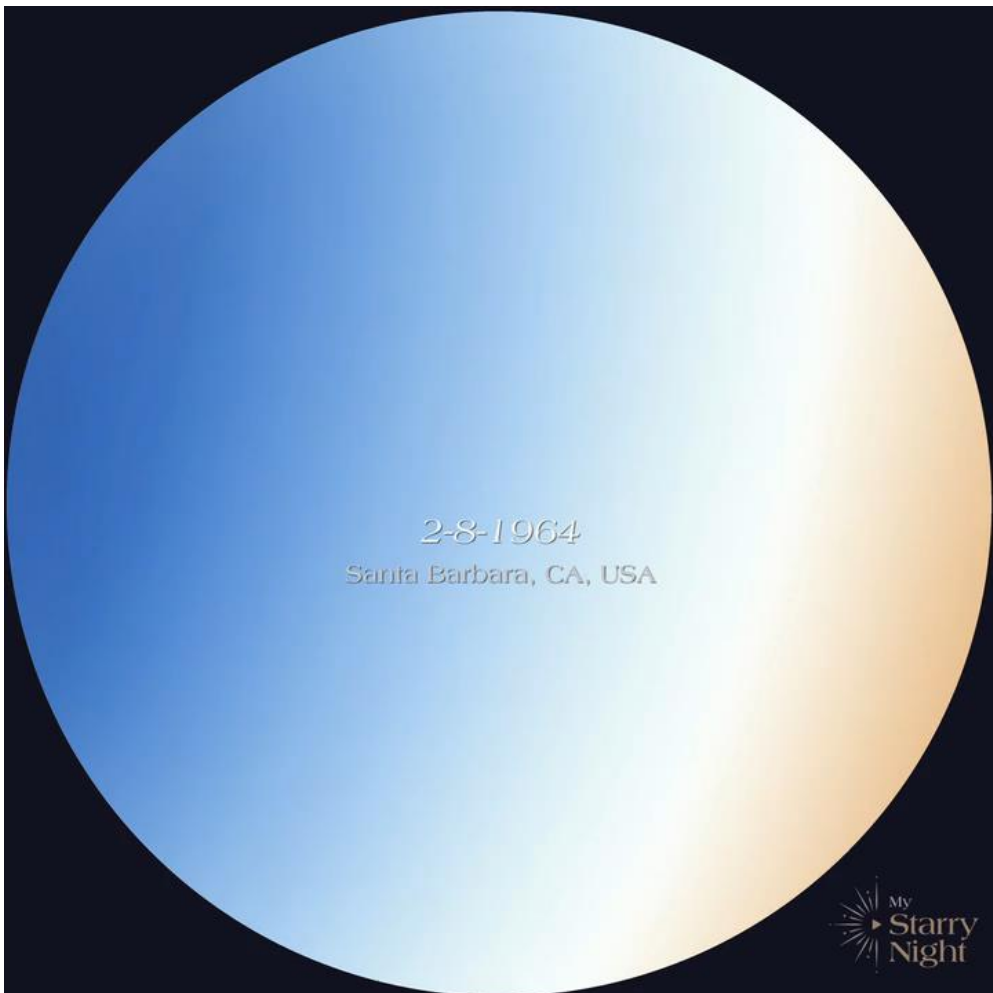


Remembering that Special Day 60 Years Ago

Crater, Serpens, Cassiopeia, Hercules, Lynx, Monoceros, Leo, Cancer, Ophiuchus, Auriga, Lyra, Ursa Major,
Hydra, Corvus, Cepheus, Centaurus, Lupus, Cygnus, Draco

*The Big Dipper is actually an asterism, not a constellation ;)

Your animation shows the night sky as it appeared from this location on this date. You can watch the stars, constellations, planets, Milky Way, and the Moon glide across the sky from sunset to sunrise. The music is created by converting the color and brightness of the highlighted stars and constellations into musical notes. A cosmic dance and celestial song as unique as your night.
